



## Consider the following this Fall to boost college savings for your students!

- ✓ Plan a K2C event at your school. You can host a save for college day and collect K2C deposits from your families or host a workshop with parents to teach them about the K2C program.
- ✓ Encourage your teachers to sign up for K2C field trips. This is an easy way for your students to learn about banks, money and savings and to make a deposit in their own accounts. Requests can be made via the K2C website, under "Get Involved."
- ✓ Coordinate a K2C activity with an afterschool program. Work with one of your afterschool programs to plan a K2C workshop, a save for college day or a visit to a bank branch.
- ✓ **Train your team.** Ensure that teachers and staff at your school can answer basic questions about the K2C program. The K2C program will host some train the trainer webinars for your school ambassador to attend.
- ✓ Plan classroom contests to engage staff and families in K2C. For example, host a pizza party for the class with the most number of K2C deposits each month.
- ✓ Add K2C to your Balanced Score Card. K2C can be included in the College and Career Readiness sections of the BSC.
